
To create a proposal in Environment Online, you must be a registered individual or entity. Refer to the Get Started Guide for details on how to register.



7. Enter the proposal's name and a short description of the proposal.



- 8. Enter the location of the proposal on the interactive map.
  - a. To access the interactive map guide, select the **question mark icon**.
  - b. The location must include:
    - i. one development envelope
    - ii. one disturbance footprint
- 9. Select **Upload or draw shape**, then draw the boundaries or upload a Shapefile.
  - a. Take note of the Shapefile requirements.

- b. Both development and footprint shapefiles can be drawn on the interactive map, or both uploaded (The development and footprint Shapefiles must be in the same format).
- 10. After adding the location, development envelope and disturbance footprint, select **Next and save.**


